CHICKASHA MUNICIPAL COURT

IN RE: Restrictions on Visitors)
 to Court Facility) STANDING ORDER 2020-1

The Centers for Disease Control having advised people to take precaution in light of the COVID-19 (coronavirus) outbreak, and noting that the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus, it is hereby

ORDERED, effective immediately, that the following persons shall not enter the Court Facility in the City of Chickasha, Oklahoma:

1. Persons who have been to any of the following countries within the last 14 days:

China, Iran, South Korea, Europe (Schengen Area): Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Monaco, San Marino, Vatican City. United Kingdom and Ireland: England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland.

THIS LIST MAY BE UPDATED IF FURTHER GUIDANCE IS RECEIVED

2. Persons who reside or have had close contact with someone who has been in one of the countries listed above for the last 14 days.
3. Persons who have been asked to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital or health agency.
4. Persons who have been diagnosed with, or have contact with, anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.
5. Persons with fever, cough or shortness of breath.

ANYONE ATTEMPTING TO ENTER IN VIOLATION OF THESE PROTOCOLS WILL BE DENIED ENTRY BY A COURT FACILITY SECURITY OFFICER.

If you have a scheduled appointment or are otherwise required to appear at the Court Facility and you are unable to appear because of any of the Restrictions 1-5 listed above, you should proceed as follows:

- If you are represented by an attorney, please contact your attorney
- Contact the Municipal Court Clerk at (405) 222-6022

These restrictions will remain in place until it is determined to be safe to remove them. People who think they may have been exposed to COVID-19 should contact their healthcare provider immediately.
